

#### NOTES:

1. Unique pole identification numbers are included on the project specific drawings.
2. Ensure pole surface where labels are to be applied is clean and dry.
3. Locate pole identification label off centre of the pole facing towards the traffic flow at the height specified.
4. Do not fix pole identification label across the central weld of the pole.
5. Where the lighting is tariff Rate 3, mount the (441) label immediately above the pole identification number, encircling the pole so as to be visible from all sides.
