Notes:

1. Depending on the road type (state-controlled or local-controlled), the department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) regions or local councils are responsible for choosing suitable locations for signage. The Queensland Police Service (QPS) is responsible for the manufacture and installation of the signs as part of the camera installation process. Signs should only be installed at locations approved by TMR and QPS. For the approval process, contact the QPS Traffic Camera Office (1300 360 610).
2. This sign is installed on the approach to and within an average speed camera zone.
3. Edge strip comprises 50 mm x 50 mm blue and white checker.
4. Sign requires a clear film overlay fitted to protect it from graffiti.
