Notes:

1. This sign may be used at roadworks where traffic control is in operation and queuing occurs.
2. When used, this sign shall be located in advance of the primary PREPARE TO STOP sign and may be repeated if required where the length of the queue varies at different times of the day.
3. When used, this sign shall be used with the "TURN OFF HAZARD LIGHTS" sign, refer to page 2.
4. Refer to the Guideline - Traffic Management at Works on Roads, Chapter 1, Clause 2.2 for additional information and guidance.
