#### Notes:

1. "BURNING OFF" (TC9869) may be used in lieu of "SMOKE HAZARD" and without supporting signs/traffic controller when there is no smoke risk.
2. Same signing arrangement to be used at all other approaches to the work area.
3. Special care determined by an on site risk analysis may be required when very thick smoke is present. This may be necessary to minimise the likelihood of vehicles stopping within the smoke zone and posing a hazard to following vehicles.
4. Refer TC1167 for alternative multimessage signing configuration.
5. Ensure a minimum of 150 m visibility for oncoming traffic.
6. Traffic controllers should be illuminated at night using portable floodlights.
7. A speed limit, 60 AHEAD sign (G9-79) may be used in lieu of the first (80) R4-1. In such cases the distance between the two signs can be 2D.
