1. This emergency marker sticker is to be installed on complex road systems such as tunnels or on other road environments such as where GPS is not available or suitable to enable response by emergency services to a specific location.
2. \* Legend is Arial bold.
3. \*\* Insert appropriate alpha-numeric legends as define in note 4.
4. The numbering convention used is set out on a single vertical line in two sections.

### Section 1: Road name. e.g. AS

The first two letters represent the road on which the marker is located and the direction of travel. ( e.g AS refers to A for Airport Link (the tunnel) and S for the direction of travel.

### Section 2: Section of road on which the marker is located. e.g.006.

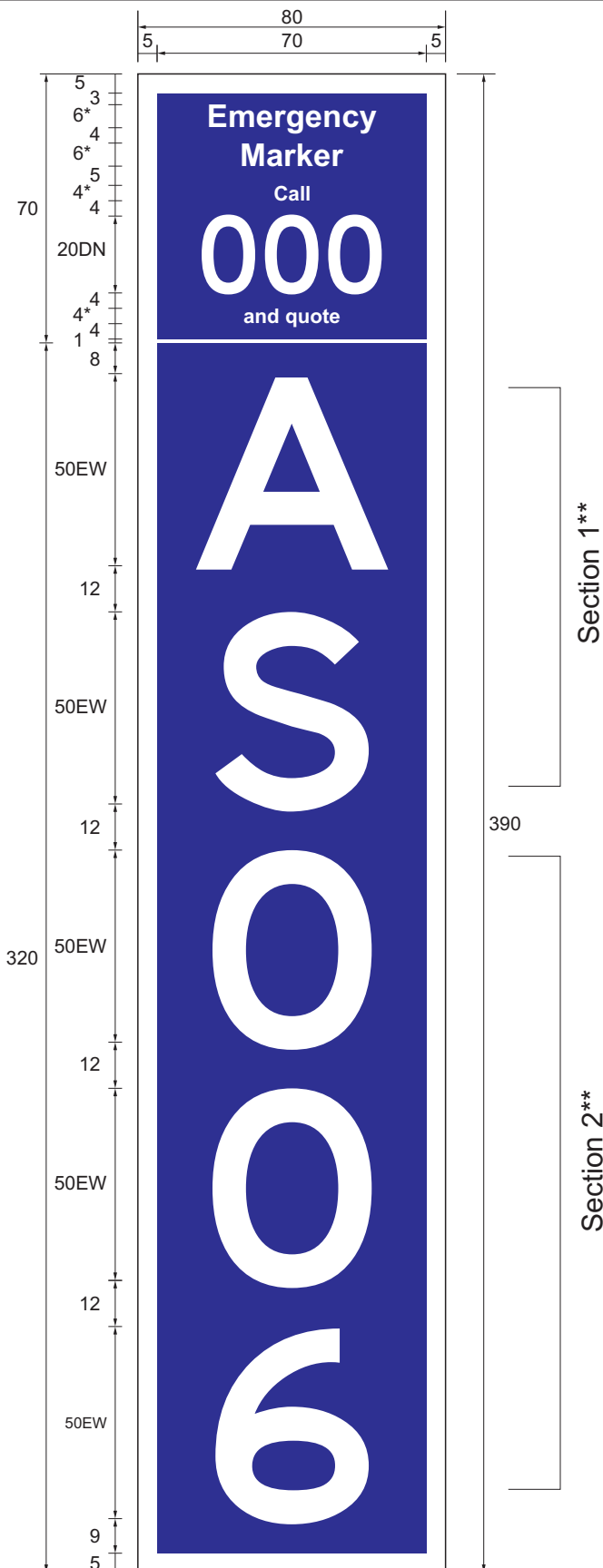
Subsequent sections of road in the same direction would use consecutive numbering.
