2. Images are to be high resolution images printed on a transparent overlay on a Class 1W retroreflective background.
3. The images must be approved and supported by the relevant Regional Tourism Organisation (RTO). If desired, a single image across the whole sign may be used in lieu of two images.
4. Protective overlay film recommended.
5. *1 - Insert either 'WELCOME TO' or 'WELCOME TO THE' according to the list on page 3.
6. *2 - Insert appropriate tourist region name, e.g. CAPRICORN REGION (see page 3 for list).
7. *3 - Insert appropriate tourist slogan. Text to be Helvetica or equivalent. The tourist slogan must be approved and supported by both the relevant RTO and local governments.
8. *4 - Font is Helvetica Bold or equivalent.
9. *5 - Font is Helvetica or equivalent.
10. B size is only to be used on multi-lane high speed roads, e.g. motorways.
