Note

1. The sign must only be used at official, approved suicide 'hotspot' locations. Approval will be required from Lifeline (Telephone: 02 6215 9400). This sign may be installed at a location with either a history or high risk of suicide incidents TMR Traffic Engineering Team trafficengineering.support@tmr.qld.gov.au can advise on risk.
2. The phone number on the sign provides a direct connection to a mental health expert with specialised expertise and training.
3. The purpose of this sign is to encouraging 'help seeking', and facilitating opportunities for third party interventions.
4. Prior to installation, an action plan must be developed in consultation with local police, emergency services and other key stakeholders. This plan must be submitted to Lifeline for 'hotspot' status approval. The plan will be used to train and inform the telephone operator on an appropriate response when a call is received from a specific location. Telephone: (02) 6215 9400.
5. Phone number (13 11 15) may be modified as required only upon consultation with Lifeline.
