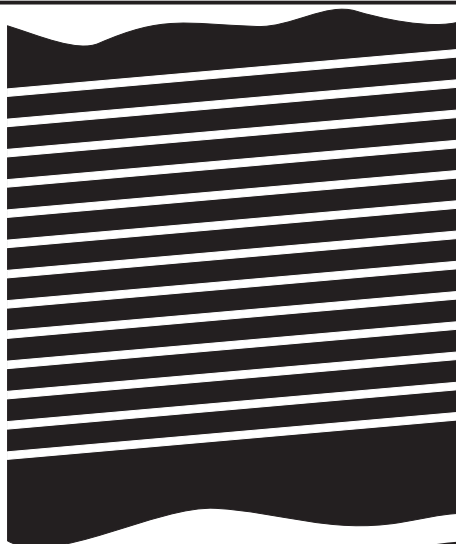
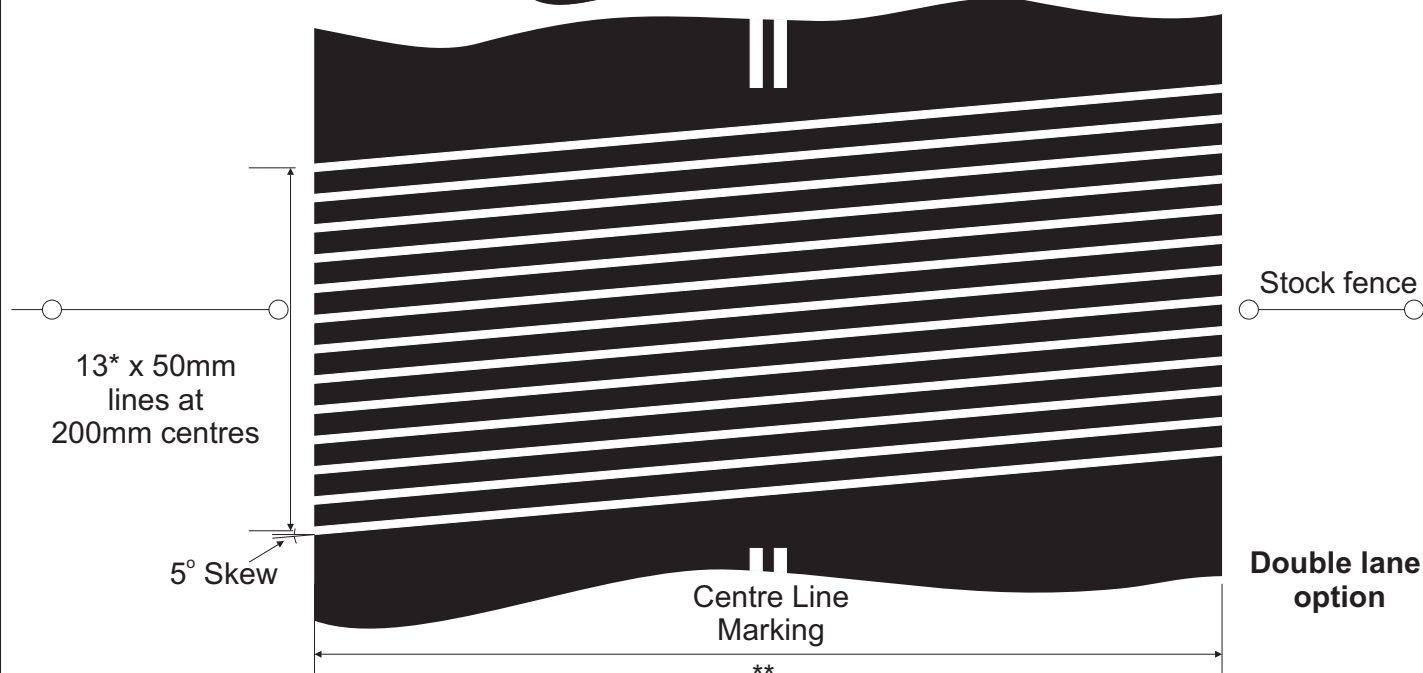



Stock fence

Notes

3. No centre line marking shall enter the painted livestock grid area.
4. All pavement markings to conform with AS 4049.1 and the Guide to Pavement Markings.
5. * A standard of 13 lines may be used where larger animals (e.g. cattle) are concerned however 9 lines may be used in instances where smaller animals (e.g. sheep) are concerned.
6. ** The painted livestock grid shall span the entire width of the sealed section of roadway.
7. Refer to page 2 for squared set out option.

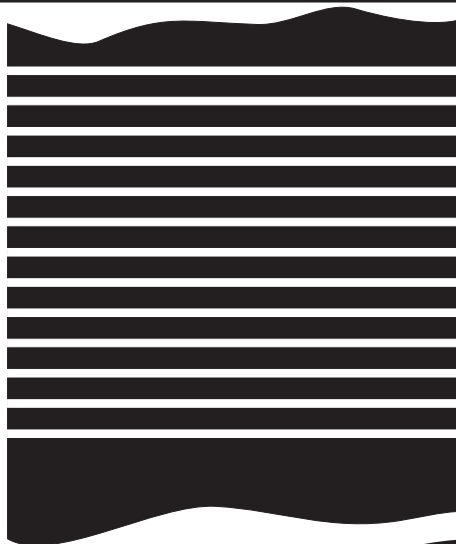

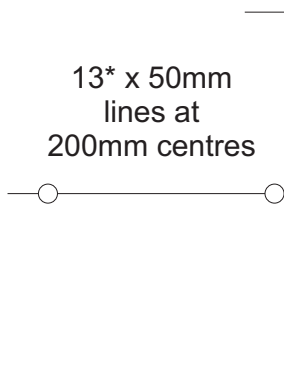
