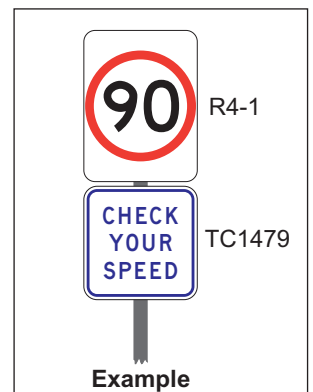

General Notes

- Initially this sign is only to be installed as part of a Department of Transport and Main Roads road safety trial.

- As a guide, signs will only be permitted where the requirements outlined below can be met.

Technical Notes

- This sign is designed to be installed under a R4-1 speed limit sign to remind drivers of the limit applicable and to check their speed. While the primary application is on routes where road environment cues might not align with driver's expectations, the sign can be used in other situations as required (e.g. at known speed problem areas).
- It may only be installed under an existing R4-1 speed limit repeater sign (it must not be used as a stand alone sign).
- The sign width shall match the width of the existing R4-1 sign.
- Signs should be installed under the first repeater speed limit sign within the zone.
- Signs should be installed for both directions of travel (ideally on the first repeater sign at each end of the zone)
- In long reduced speed limit zones, signs may be installed under existing speed limit repeater signs at more than one location in each direction.
- TC1528 has been developed for use in situations where repeater signs are not installed at the required location.
