Notes:

1. This sign may be used in advance of an intersection that leads to a Local Tourist Area. A Local Tourist Area has a central tourist hub for the surrounding area which must include an accredited Visitor Information Centre and is generally located off but accessed from a State Strategic Tourist Route.
2. Image is to be a single high resolution image printed on a transparent overlay on a Class 1W retroreflective background.
3. The image must be approved and supported by the relevant Regional Tourism Organisation (RTO).
4. Protective overlay film recommended.
5. *1 - Insert appropriate Local Tourist Area, e.g. GLADSTONE.
6. *2 - Insert appropriate direction, e.g. RIGHT.
7. *3 - Insert appropriate distance in kilometres, e.g. 1.
8. Size A sign may be installed where it is located in a low speed zone (70 km/h and below) or when physical space constraints do not allow size B.
9. Insert up to a maximum of 4 separate local tourist natural attractions (avoid commercial attractions).
