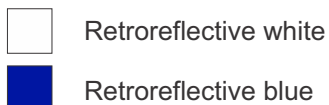




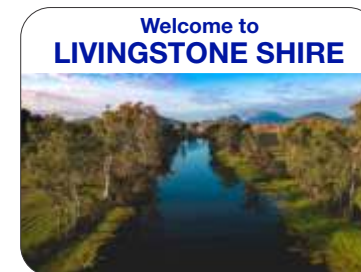

2. If Local Government welcome signs are to be installed, they must be installed at the boundary between two Local Government Areas (LGA's), or very close to the boundary but within the LGA, and should also be installed for both LGA's.
3. Signs are to be installed on the left side of the road with a minimum setback of 3 metres from the left hand edge line of the road.
4. * Insert appropriate local government area name.
5. # Text to be Helvetica Bold or equivalent.
6. ## - Dimension "k" for the image height may be increased if required to suit the approved image. In this case, dimension "b" will also be increased by the same amount. The increase of total height of the sign is not to exceed dimension b (max). See example.

8. Image is to be a single high resolution image with reference to TMR's image selection guidelines in TRUM Volume 3 Part 7.
9. The image must be approved and supported by both the relevant Regional Tourism Organisation (RTO) and local government.
10. Image to be printed on a transparent overlay on a Class 1W retroreflective white background.
11. Protective overlay film is recommended for this sign.
12. Where single lane, dual lane and motorway signs are required, utilise TC2354_1A, TC2354_1B and TC2354_1C signs respectively.
13. Where signs with a tourist slogan may be required, refer to page 2.

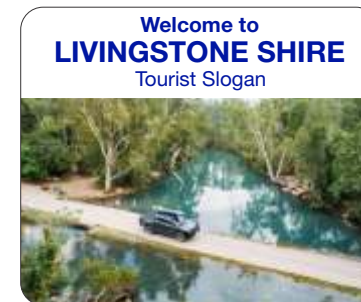

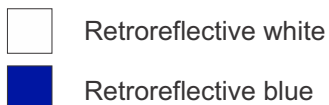
